

## The EuP DIRECTIVE – STATEMENT OF INTENT

The European Parliament established a framework for the setting of ecodesign requirements for energy-using products with EuP 2005/32/EC and EuP 278/2009 commonly known as Energy using Product (EuP) directives.

The directives seek to improve energy efficiency of energy using products (EuPs) to reduce the overall negative environmental impact and promote a sustainable environment. The EuP 2005/32/EC directive includes specific criteria for the selection of the products that must comply. Due to the defined criteria, this directive does not apply to CognitiveTPG Products.

Notwithstanding, CognitiveTPG remains committed to following the power consumption guidelines set by the EU with future products. All CognitiveTPG products continue to carry the Declaration of Conformity and CE label.
