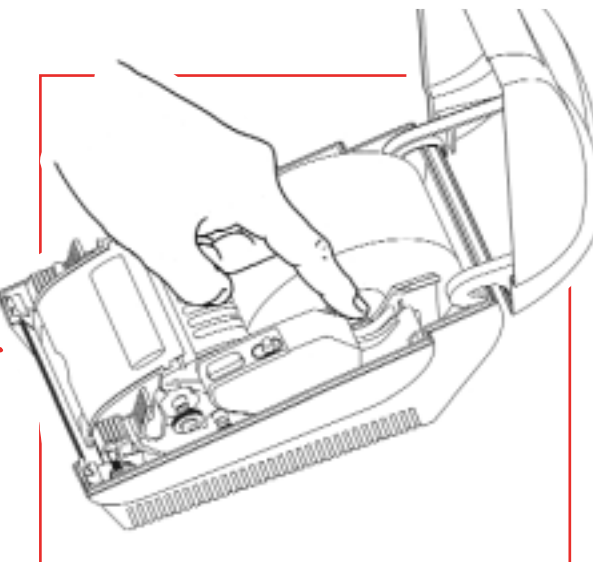

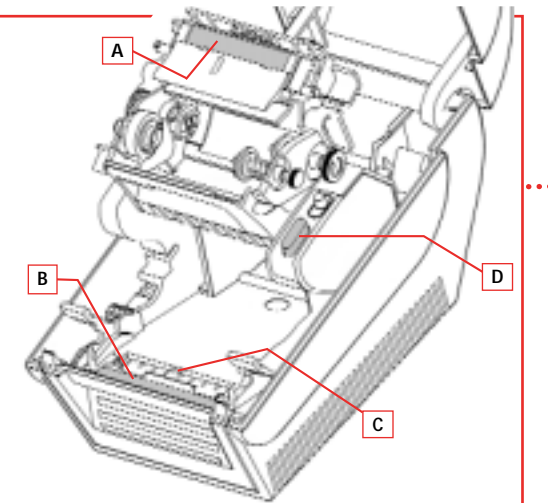
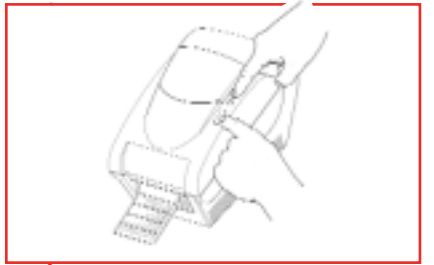
With the media roll loaded, press the green guide lock for easier media installation next time.

- Press the illuminated READY button once. The light goes out.

- Hold the blue FEED button and press READY once. Release the blue FEED button when the printer starts to print a self test label.

- Press READY twice to return to normal operating mode.

Important! After performing a self-test, the printer is placed in data dump mode and cannot print normal labels until you press READY twice.



Clean the print head (A), drive roller (B) and the index sensor (C) with a soft, lint free cloth saturated with 99% isopropyl alcohol. Press the FEED button (D) to clean all sides of the roller.

Caution! Incorrectly cleaning the printer will cause permanent damage and void the printer's warranty. Cognitive recommends using a certified cleaning pen for all your printer's cleaning requirements, P/N 60-14-00-0002.

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WARNING - SHOCK HAZARD and STATIC DISCHARGE:



Never operate the printer in a location where it can get wet, personal injury could result. The discharge of electrostatic energy that accumulates on the surface of the human body or other surfaces can damage or destroy the print head or electronic components used in this device. DO NOT TOUCH the print head or the electronic components under the print head carriage.

ALWAYS TURN POWER OFF before: (1) connecting any cables (2) performing any cleaning or maintenance operations, (3) moving the printer.

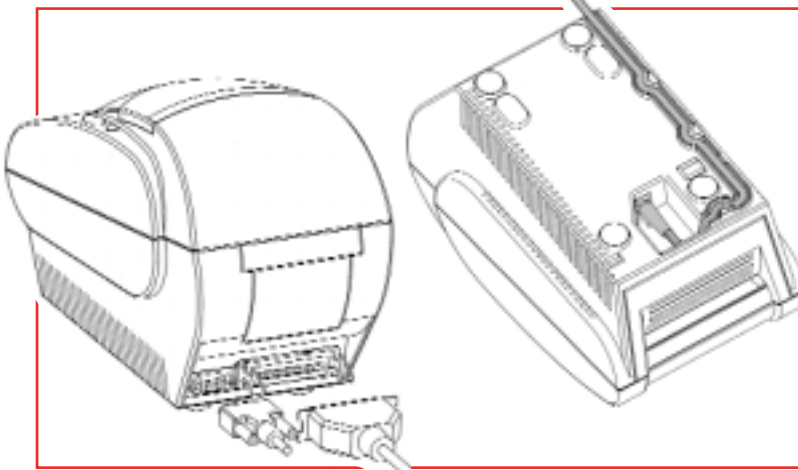
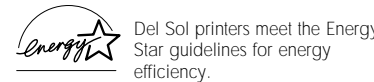

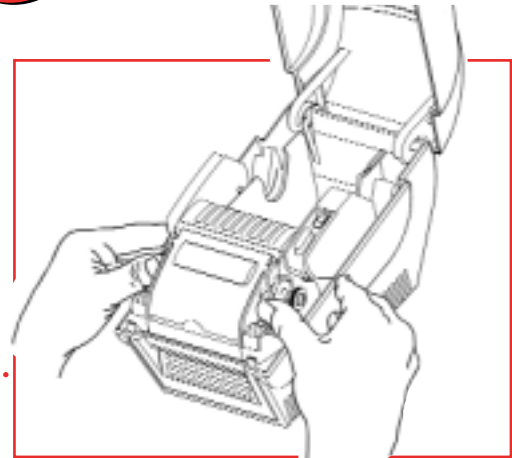

1 POWER & CABLES



Connect a parallel cable or a null modem serial cable to the back of the printer. Connect the power cable under the printer, then route the cable through the cord channel and plug in.

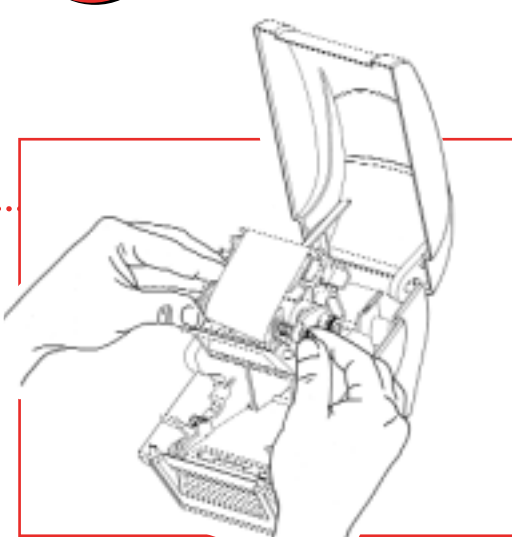
2 OPEN



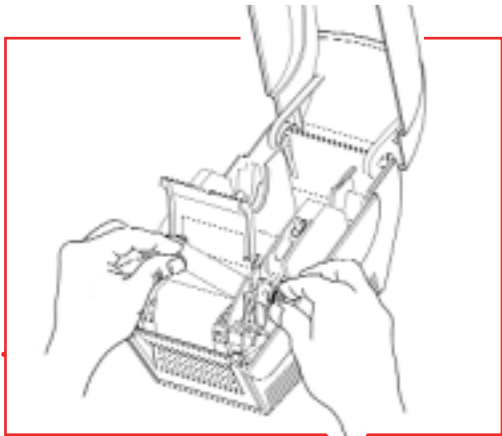
Open the dust cover. Press the black latches to release the print mechanism, then lift the mechanism until it locks in place.

Note: The printhead latches require some force to release.

3 RIBBON (Thermal Transfer Only)



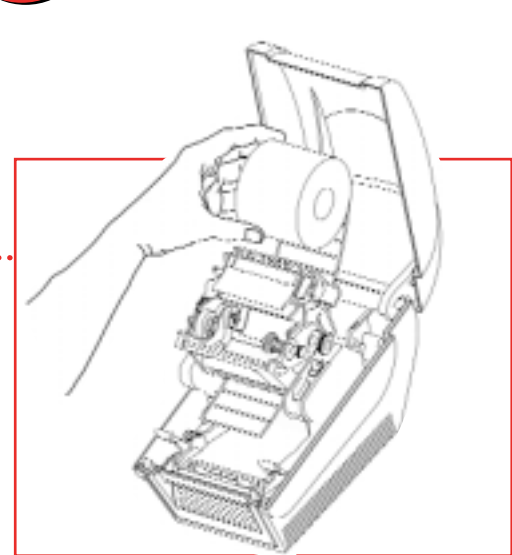
A. Pull out the small green knob and hold. Align the ribbon supply roll notches with the mounts and release the knob.



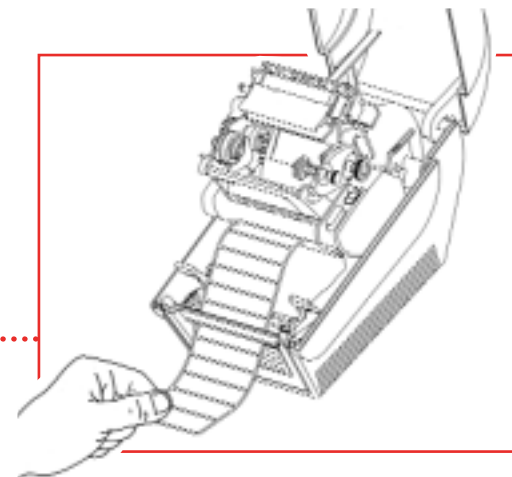
B. Lower the print mechanism and open the mechanism cover. Install the take-up core in the same way as the supply roll. Turn the take up knob clockwise until the ribbon is taut.

Note: A little wrinkling in the ribbon is normal and will not cause printing problems.

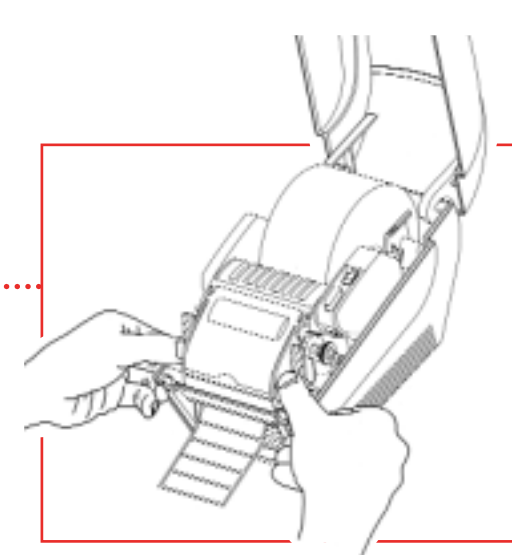
4 MEDIA



A. Load the media with the imaging side face up.



B. Slide the media under the print head and through the slot in the front panel. Pull the media taut.



C. Lower the print mechanism and press down firmly to secure both latches.

Note: The latches click when fully closed.
